

Day care center for children and young people with special needs

Senehasa Children's Resource Centre is a therapy center developed as a day care center through a private initiative by parents of children with disabilities. The children and young people receive specific therapies to support their physical and mental development, enabling them to participate more effectively in social life. Their parents are also trained and motivated to actively participate in the therapeutic measures.

The Sri Lanka Association Hamburg e.V. has supported the work since 2009 by funding two full-time therapist positions.

We give the older young people the opportunity to become independent after school and contribute a small amount to their families' income. By funding an oven and providing baking utensils, parents can guide the young people to bake their own cookies and snacks. They are now practicing selling their products in front of a nearby hospital. This positive experience is strengthening their sense of responsibility.











Of note are the annual events, which are prepared with great dedication. The children and young people perform as dancers and actors, wearing colourful costumes and accompanied by music. This strengthens their skills and builds self-confidence within the community.
